Dear Friends,

On behalf of Project Restore's Board of Directors and staff, we welcome you to Project Restore's Los Angeles Heritage Awards Gala.

We are pleased to honor AC Martin, Inc. and the Martin Family who have exemplified leadership, innovation, and true dedication towards the revitalization of the City of Los Angeles. AC Martin, Inc. and the Martin Family have been a part of Los Angeles history for over 100 years, reshaping Downtown with projects such as the city's first high-rise, our beloved Los Angeles City Hall, and also the Los Angeles Department of Water & Power building. AC Martin continues to lead this city into the future with significant projects such as the Wilshire Grand. The third generation of Martin family architects, led by Chris Martin and David Martin, are continuing to shape the metropolitan skyline of our great city.

Project Restore's unique public-private partnership has allowed us to successfully restore historic city landmarks which play unique roles as centerpieces of our city's history. As emblems of city pride, they showcase the best architectural talents of their time. This year, Project Restore completed a \$4.3 million restoration of the historic Hollyhock House, a crown jewel of Los Angeles architecture designed by Frank Lloyd Wright. The home reopened to the public after three years of major restoration work with a grand opening event, which received international attention. The U.S. Department of the Interior recently announced its decision to nominate the home to the UNESCO World Heritage List, which includes icons like the Taj Mahal and Statue of Liberty.

Our ongoing efforts on behalf of the City have led us on our newest endeavors to restore the decorative paint and ceiling murals in Los Angeles City Hall, the work of two famous artisans —Anthony Heinsbergen and Herman Sachs. Although much work has already been completed since the building reopened, a great deal more remains to be done as the building ages and the irreplaceable, historic painted ceilings and murals are deteriorating.

Simultaneously, we will be seeking funding for restoration work at Residence A, a Los Angeles Historic Cultural Monument within the Aline Barnsdall Park Complex. The building was sometimes referred to as the "The Director's House," one of two residential buildings that represent the first work in Los Angeles of the office of Frank Lloyd Wright during his "Romanza Period." It was originally used by visiting artists and directors and later as classroom space. The structure is in need of major seismic retrofit and restoration work.

Project Restore remains strongly committed to preserving Los Angeles history, architecture and culture. We are deeply grateful for your support throughout the years and we congratulate our 2015 honorees, AC Martin, Inc. and the Martin Family.




